He has published work in various journals across the country including *CutBank*, *FIELD*, *ForkLift Ohio*, *The Columbia Poetry Review*, and *The Colorado Review*. The recipient of the Dorothy Sargent Rosenberg and Ruskin Art Club awards for poetry, he currently lives in Bangkok, Thailand as a Fulbright Scholar where he is studying southeast Asian poetry.
